I want to thank you for your continued support and flexibility as we navigate this school year. I also want to thank you for the words of support that many have shared regarding the health of the Summit student who recently tested positive for COVID-19.

We continue to monitor this situation with our local Health Department. At this time, we do not have any additional confirmed cases.

As a reminder, Summit continues to offer voluntary COVID testing each week to students and staff for added assurance of the health and safety on campus. This Wednesday, October 7, we will also be offering drive-through COVID testing from 10:00 - 11:00 for any remote learning students. There is no cost to families for participation, however a copy of the child's insurance card is needed, along with a signed consent form.
